22.403-4 Executive Orders 13658 and 14026.

Executive Order (E.O.) 13658 established minimum *wages* for certain workers at \$10.10 per hour. The E.O. 13658 rate has increased each year since 2015, rising to \$11.25 on January 1, 2022. As of January 30, 2022, E.O. 13658 is superseded by E.O. 14026 to the extent that it is inconsistent with E.O. 14026; the minimum wage rate for certain workers is increased to \$15.00 per hour. The wage rate is subject to annual increases by an amount determined by the Secretary of Labor. See <u>subpart 22.19</u>. The clause at <u>52.222-55</u>, Minimum *Wages* for Contractor Workers under Executive Order 14026, requires the E.O. 14026 minimum wage rate to be paid if it is higher than other minimum wage rates, such as the <u>subpart 22.4</u> statutory wage determination amount.
