25.405 Caribbean Basin Trade Initiative.

Under the Caribbean Basin Trade Initiative, the *United States* Trade Representative has determined that, for *acquisitions* covered by the *WTO GPA*, *Caribbean Basin country end products, construction material*, and services *must* be treated as *eligible products*. In accordance with Section 201 (a)(3) of the Dominican Republic-Central America-*United States* Free Trade Implementation Act (Pub. L. 109-53) (<u>19 U.S.C. 4031</u>), when the CAFTA-DR agreement enters into force with respect to a country, that country is no longer designated as a beneficiary country for purposes of the Caribbean Basin Economic Recovery Act, and is therefore no longer included in the definition of "*Caribbean Basin country*" for purposes of the Caribbean Basin Trade Initiative.
