As prescribed in <u>52.107(f)</u>, insert the following clause in *solicitations* and contracts that include any FAR or supplemental clause with an authorized deviation. Whenever any FAR or supplemental clause is used with an authorized deviation, the *contracting officer shall* identify it by the same number, title, and date assigned to the clause when it is used without deviation, include regulation name for any supplemental clause, except that the *contracting officer shall* insert "(DEVIATION)" after the date of the clause.
