Subpart 213.70 - SIMPLIFIED ACQUISITION PROCEDURES UNDER THE 8(A) PROGRAM

Parent topic: Part 213 - SIMPLIFIED ACQUISITION PROCEDURES

213.7001 Procedures.

(a)(1) For acquisitions that are otherwise appropriate to be conducted using procedures set forth in this part, and also eligible for the 8(a) Program, contracting officers may use—

(i) For sole source purchase orders not exceeding the simplified acquisition threshold, the procedures in PGI $\underline{219.804-2}$ (2); or

(ii) For other types of acquisitions, the procedures in PGI $\underline{219.8}$, excluding the procedures in PGI $\underline{219.804-2}$ (2); or

(2) The procedures for award to the Small Business Administration in FAR subpart 19.8.

(b) To comply with section 898 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2016 (Pub. L. 114-92), contracting officers shall not use the sole source authority at FAR 6.302-5(b)(4) to purchase religious-related services to be performed on a United States military installation. For competitive purchases under the 8(a) program, contracting officers shall not exclude a nonprofit organization from the competition. See <u>219.270</u> for additional procedures.

213.7002 Purchase orders.

The contracting officer need not obtain a contractor's written acceptance of a purchase order or modification of a purchase order for an acquisition under the 8(a) Program pursuant to 219.804-2(2).
