1.402 Policy.

Unless precluded by law, executive order, or regulation, *deviations* from the FAR *may* be granted as specified in this subpart when necessary to meet the specific needs and requirements of each agency. The development and testing of new techniques and methods of *acquisition should* not be stifled simply because such action would require a FAR *deviation*. The fact that *deviation* authority is required *should* not, of itself, deter agencies in their development and testing of new techniques and *acquisition* methods. Refer to <u>31.101</u> for instructions concerning *deviations* pertaining to the subject matter of <u>part 31</u>, Contract Cost Principles and Procedures. *Deviations* are not authorized with respect to <u>30.201-3</u> and <u>30.201-4</u>, or the requirements of the Cost Accounting Standards Board (CASB) rules and regulations (<u>48 CFR chapter 99</u>). Refer to <u>30.201-5</u> for instructions concerning waivers pertaining to Cost Accounting Standards.
