15.207 Handling proposals and information.

- (a) Upon receipt at the location specified in the *solicitation*, proposals and information received in response to a request for information (RFI) *shall* be marked with the date and time of receipt and *shall* be transmitted to the designated officials.
- (b) Proposals *shall* be safeguarded from unauthorized disclosure throughout the source selection process. (See <u>3.104</u> regarding the disclosure of *source selection information* (<u>41 U.S.C. chapter 21</u>, Restrictions on Obtaining and Disclosing Certain Information). Information received in response to an RFI *shall* be safeguarded adequately from unauthorized disclosure.
- (c) If any portion of a proposal received by the *contracting officer* electronically or by facsimile is unreadable, the *contracting officer* immediately *shall* notify the *offeror* and permit the *offeror* to resubmit the unreadable portion of the proposal. The method and time for resubmission *shall* be prescribed by the *contracting officer* after consultation with the *offeror*, and documented in the file. The resubmission *shall* be considered as if it were received at the date and time of the original unreadable submission for the purpose of determining timeliness under $\underline{15.208}$ (a), provided the *offeror* complies with the time and format requirements for resubmission prescribed by the *contracting officer*.
